Objectives: ORISE is making a special effort to recruit undergraduate and graduate students for internships in the Washington, DC metro area and other locations throughout the country. This 10-week summer program is designed to provide research and practical experience to college students in **BIOLOGY, BUSINESS, CHEMISTRY, COMPUTER SCIENCE, ENGINEERING and PHYSICS.**

Stipends: weekly stipend of **\$450** for undergraduates, **\$550** for graduate students; **\$125** per week housing allowance and limited reimbursement of local transportation costs.

Deadline: continuing

Travel: one round-trip travel from your home or academic institution to assigned facility, if greater than 60 miles one way will be reimbursed. Students appointed to the Washington, DC area will be housed in dorms in DC.

Eligibility: students must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited U.S. college or university. US citizens only.
