<b>Description:</b>	The NRC Historically Black Colleges and Universities Research Participation Program supports research appointments for faculty, graduate students and undergraduate students at federal laboratories, fosters the establishment of faculty/student teams, and provides support for on-campus research projects.

<b>Stipends:</b>	●Undergraduate Students: <b>\$500/week</b> ●Graduate students: <b>\$600/week</b> ● <b>Faculty:</b> Equal to your monthly university salary or <b>\$3,800 per month</b> , whichever is greater (based on full-time participation). Full-time faculty members and full-time students in good standing at an HBCU	
<b>Eligibility:</b>	●Full-time faculty members or full-time students in good standing at an HBCU ●U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents ●Undergraduate students minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale ●Graduate students: minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.	
<b>Research Sites:</b>	●Laboratories where NRC mission-related research is being conducted ●Your own HBCU campus ●Host universities that have principal investigators with NRC grants.	
<b>Duration:</b>	10 to 12 weeks for summer appointments: some part-time appointments of one year	
<b>Frequency:</b>	annually	
<b>Awards made:</b>	number varies
